



Terms and conditions of participation

#SIXHackathon

Participants hereby declare that they are in agreement with the code of conduct set out below and the rights to the results of their work.

By clicking on the terms and conditions of participation in order to register to participate in the #SIXHackathon, participants are deemed to have read and accepted the terms and conditions of the #SIXHackathon of SIX Group Services Ltd ("SIX").

1. Code of conduct

Participants:

- I. shall, in relation to programming prototypes etc., refrain from creating any content that could be considered illegal and/or obscene, offensive, defamatory, indecent, pornographic, unsuitable, racist, xenophobic or in any other way objectionable in line with general moral standards and/or according to the decision of SIX or that would/could damage the reputation of SIX. Furthermore, any content created through programming cannot involve any commercial content or content that could cause damage to other parties, e.g. viruses, trojan horses, spyware, phishing solicitations or instructions on creating such content.
- II. shall refrain from accessing, storing (saving) and sending content or data with illegal, copyright-infringing, sexist, racist, offensive or otherwise objectionable ideologies. Paid-for content may not be accessed. Access to websites and other systems may be restricted or refused.
- III. must clearly reference all sources/source materials when presenting the results.
- IV. shall only use graphical elements belonging to SIX with the prior written consent of SIX.
- V. shall comply with the house rules in force at the event location as well as any instructions given by the organizers on location.
- VI. shall neither enter nor use any rooms, installations or systems at the event location that are not intended to be used as part of the #SIXHackathon.
- VII. are prepared to present the results of their work at the end of the #SIXHackathon in plenary and in front of a jury.
- VIII. assume responsibility for any damage they cause to the premises, installations and systems at the event location. In this respect and to the extent permitted by law, SIX declines all liability.
- IX. agree to return or irreversibly destroy any working materials provided by SIX, in particular SIX data carriers, after the end of the #SIXHackathon.

In the event of a breach of this code of conduct, SIX reserves the right to remove or exclude participant(s) and or team(s) from the #SIXHackathon without providing any further reason.

SIX reserves the right to assert claims for damages and/or amends or to initiate criminal proceedings.

2. Rights to results of work



Participants hereby agree that both they and SIX may use, further develop and, in particular, exploit the results of participants' work from the #SIXHackathon. It is possible for participants and SIX to each make further use of the results of their work either alone or as part of a future partnership/temporary change of function. However, neither party has any claim to a future partnership/temporary change of function. If SIX acts alone in making further use of the results of participants' work, it will not owe participants any reimbursement or remuneration in this respect.
