SIX to Implement Extraordinary Index Basket Adjustments Due to Helvetia-Baloise Merger

07.11.2025

SIX will implement extraordinary adjustments to the composition of the SLI, SMIM, and SPI Mid-cap indices, effective 22 December 2025, in connection with the ongoing merger between Helvetia Holding and Baloise Holding. This decision is based on a recommendation from the Index Commission and is in accordance with the SIX index rules.

The adjustments will be executed in two phases:

1) Merger Execution: Effective 8 December 2025 (Ex-Date):

Adjustments to the number of shares and free float will be made at the time of the merger. No backfilling will occur for the SMIM (remains at 29 constituents), SPI Mid-cap (remains at 79 constituents), or other indices with fixed components.

2) Extraordinary Index Composition Adjustments: Effective 22 December 2025:

Following the quarterly index review on 19 December 2025 (after market close), SIX will implement extraordinary adjustments to the SLI index, based on the latest available equity selection list. At the same time, and based on the same equity selection list, the SMIM and SPI Mid-cap indices will be backfilled to restore their original number of constituents, returning to 30 and 80 components respectively.
