This message provides some additional information about the SMF Replacement project.

Launch of SIX MDDX Phase 2 in the Membertest environment

The Membertest Phase 2 will start on **Monday, 4 September 2017** in the Membertest environment that is available to Data Vendors as communicated and planned. The SWXess platform will be upgraded on the weekend of 1-3 September 2017.

Please note: Due to a re-scheduling of the integration of file-based content, Reference Data Messages (see section 6 of the SIX MDDX Interface Specification) will not be available with Phase 2 in the Membertest environment and therefore also not as of launch of the SIX MDDX on 23.10.2017. The following services are concerned:

- SFD - Swiss Fund Data on investment funds
- CXR - CONNEXOR electronic reference data
- DP - Derivatives Partners Valuation Service for Structured Products

However, the above mentioned services will still be disseminated via the SMF that runs in parallel to the SIX MDDX for at least 6 months after the SMF Replacement going-live.

During this final test phase, Data Vendors are strongly encouraged to test their feed handlers including:

- **Full SIX MDDX functionality for MiFID II compliance**, already delivered with Phase 1
- **Index and Prices messages** newly available with Phase 2 (see section 5 of the SIX MDDX Interface Specification)
