## Additional Reference Data on the MDDX in the Member Test Environment

Based on the <u>SIX Exfeed Message 02/2018</u>, the below listed reference data will be added to the member test environment.

• Swiss Fund Data (SFD)

On Monday, 19 February 2018, Data Vendors will be able to test the aforementioned data (see section 6 of the SIX MDDX Interface Specification) incl. CONNEXOR reference data and the Derivatives Partners Valuation Service for Structured Products, as communicated in the SIX Exfeed Message above. <u>The go-live in the Production environment is on 19 March 2018.</u>

## SMF Decommissioning

As planned, the SMF will be decommissioned at the end of June 2018, i.e. also end of parallel run with the MDDX.
