This message provides important information concerning changes to SIX MDDX.

We kindly remind you, as announced in [SIX Exfeed Message No. 14/2018](#), that the hardware infrastructure upgrade of SIX MDDX will go ahead on Saturday, 29 September 2018. Therefore, the switch of IP addresses on the SoupBinTCP servers in the **Production environment is mandatory**.

## SIX MDDX switch of IP addresses

The change of IP addresses in the **Production environment** will take place on **Saturday, 29 September 2018**.

SIX will deploy a simulation server prior to the IP address change to allow you to carry out initial connectivity tests. From Monday, 17 September 2018 to Friday, 28 September 2018 (from 09:00 to 21:00 CEST), you will be able to connect to the new IP addresses using your current production connection port(s) and SoupBinTCP username(s). To prevent accidental misconfiguration, the SoupBinTCP password will be set to "SIMULATION". The simulation server will only send heartbeat packets after the initial session and directory messages. There will not be any data traffic during the day.

As of Saturday, 29 September 2018, SIX will no longer disseminate SIX MDDX market data via the old IP addresses in the Production environment, therefore the switch to the new IP addresses is **mandatory** for all SIX MDDX data receivers.

On Saturday, 29 September 2018 from 12:00 to 20:00 CEST and on Sunday 30 September 2018 from 12:00 to 20:00 CEST, you will be able to test connectivity to the newly deployed SIX software on the new IP addresses using your current Production connection port(s), SoupBinTCP username(s) and your own SoupBinTCP password(s).

We would like to make you aware that these changes have a serious impact on your ability to receive and to disseminate MDDX data and are **mandatory for all vendors**.



These changes only affect the SIX MDDX SoupBinTCP connectivity, and will cause no changes to the SIX MDDX messages.
