Release Schedule SMR12

SIX Swiss Exchange will introduce the SWXess Maintenance Release 12 (SMR12) to the SWXess trading platform. SMR12 contains required interface changes for SWXess participants.

The main changes of SMR12 are:

- Introduction of multicurrency trading in Quote on Demand (QOD) for ETFs and ETPs
- Other improvements to On Book trading and Trade Reporting
- There will be MDDX changes to seven market data messages and two session and directory messages

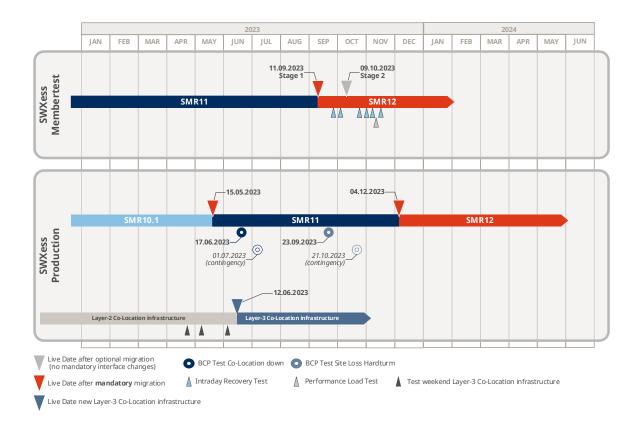
