1 Migration Weekend (24–27 July 2026)

The migration to the MC01 environment will take place over the weekend from **Friday, 24 July 2026 to Monday, 27 July 2026**.

1.1 Detailed Schedule

The following timeline applies to participants:

- Friday, 24 July
 - Start of migration activities
- Saturday, 25 July
 - Migration activities in progress
- Sunday, 26 July
 - Migration activities in progress
- Monday, 27 July
 - First trading day on Equinox in Membertest environment (MC01)
 - Testing activities can start
 - Pinging / telnet testing is available
 - Trading session connectivity testing is available

2 Important Information

2.1 Preparation Work for Participants



As outlined in the Migration Guide, participants are required to notify SIX in advance of their planned start of testing. This enables SIX to support any necessary adjustments on the participant side and to prepare the required configuration changes accordingly.

Notification must be sent via email to your Local Support Center.

2.2 MC01 Trading Hours

Equinox member test trading hours will be aligned with the existing Membertest (M01) environment. The detailed Time Schedule will be available in the [Environment Calendar](#).

If necessary, adjustments may be made to the regular schedule in order to update a test environment component or resolve a bug.

2.3 Session Setup for MC01

SIX will configure the connections available to each entity in MC01 based on the connections in the existing Membertest (M01) environment.

- All entities with one or more OTI Trading Session receive one BTI Trading Session.
- All entities with one or more IMI GLIMPSE Recovery Session will receive one MDI Recovery Session.
- Regarding MDDX connections, there will be no changes as the current ones will support the Equinox MC01 test environment.

Member Services will provide the trading session credentials via email and follow up with a phone call.

Additional users can be requested based on testing needs via email to Member Services. To ensure availability:

- Requests received **by 15 July 2026** are **guaranteed** to be available by **27 July 2026**
- Requests received after this deadline will be processed on a **best-effort basis**
