In <u>SIX Swiss Exchange message no. 36/2015</u>, SIX Swiss Exchange announced the introduction of SWXess Maintenance Release 5.1 (SMR5.1) without «Self-Match Prevention».

This message provides participants detailed information about the functionality as well as the rollout plan for «Self-Match Prevention».

Introduction

SIX Swiss Exchange plans to introduce «Self-Match Prevention» as follows:

Date	Environment
23 November 2015	New release of Self-Match Prevention available for testing in the Membertest environment
14 December 2015	Introduction of Self-Match Prevention functionality in Production environment

Configuration

Please note that when «Self-Match Prevention» is introduced for Blue Chip Shares and Mid-/Small-Cap Shares in the Production environment, all Party IDs which have «Self-Match Prevention» configured for the Membertest environment will automatically also have «Self-Match Prevention» enabled for the Production environment.

If you wish to test the «Self-Match Prevention» functionality in the Membertest environment but you do not wish to enable «Self-Match Prevention» on the go-live of the service in Production (14 December 2015), please contact Member Services (member.services@six-group.com). In order to test the «Self-Match Prevention» functionality in Membertest, you can

- configure an existing Party ID which is enabled for Membertest-only; or
- request a new Party ID for Membertest-only.

Please use the <u>PartyID and SenderCompID Configuration Form</u> for any configuration requests. Please note that any configuration changes to the Party ID setup must be requested by 9 December 2015 at the latest in order that SIX Swiss Exchange can guarantee the correct migration and configuration in the Production environment.

Regulations

The <u>Directive 3: Trading</u> containing the rules of Self-Match Prevention is published on the website of SIX Swiss Exchange. With the introduction of «Self-Match Prevention» in the Production environment, the following rules will also enter into force:

Annex A: Blue Chip Shares - Clause 2 para. 3	Self-Match Prevention is supported
Annex B: Mid-/Small-Cap Shares - Clause 2 para. 3	Self-Match Prevention is supported
