SIX Swiss Exchange AG hereby informs its participants of **the amendment to the List of Charges under the Listing Rules effective 1 January 2023** in connection with the revision of company law.

New company law

The entry into force of the new company law effective 1 January 2023 will result, among other things, in the introduction of the capital band as a legal concept, replacing what was previously the authorised capital increase. Any share capital authorised up until that point in time will remain valid until it expires. The changes made at Swiss federal level must also be reflected in the SIX Swiss Exchange AG regulations. Accordingly, the authorised capital increase will be replaced, in the List of Charges under the Listing Rules, by the capital band, with transitional provisions being introduced. The fee tariffs will remain unchanged.

Regulation

The entry into force of the new company law has an impact on the following Guideline, which has been adjusted accordingly:
