Investigation against LifeWatch AG

SIX Exchange Regulation is opening an investigation against LifeWatch AG regarding potential violations of the rules governing ad hoc publicity.

SIX Exchange Regulation, which is charged by SIX Swiss Exchange AG with the monitoring and enforcement of issuer obligations, has opened an investigation against LifeWatch AG regarding potential violations of the rules governing ad hoc publicity.

The investigation is connected with the publication of the ad hoc release dated 22 January 2014 regarding a strategic partnership as well as with the publication of the results of the financial year 2013 by ad hoc releases dated 27 February 2014 and 30 April 2014.

The duration of the investigatory proceedings is not determined. SIX Exchange Regulation will announce the findings. No further information will be provided while the investigatory proceedings are ongoing.
