High level assessment

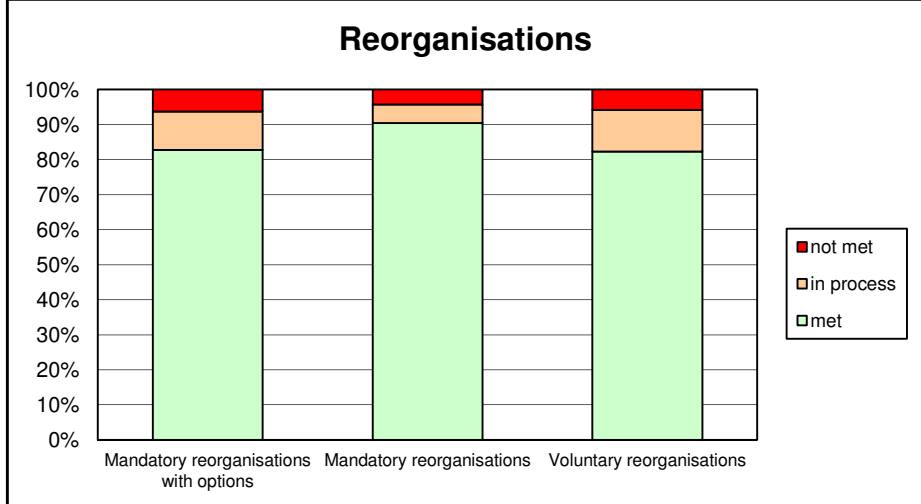
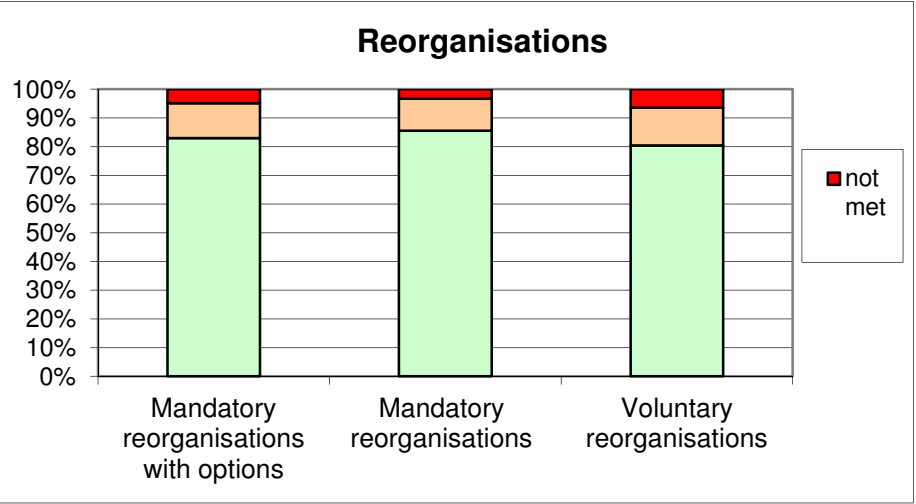
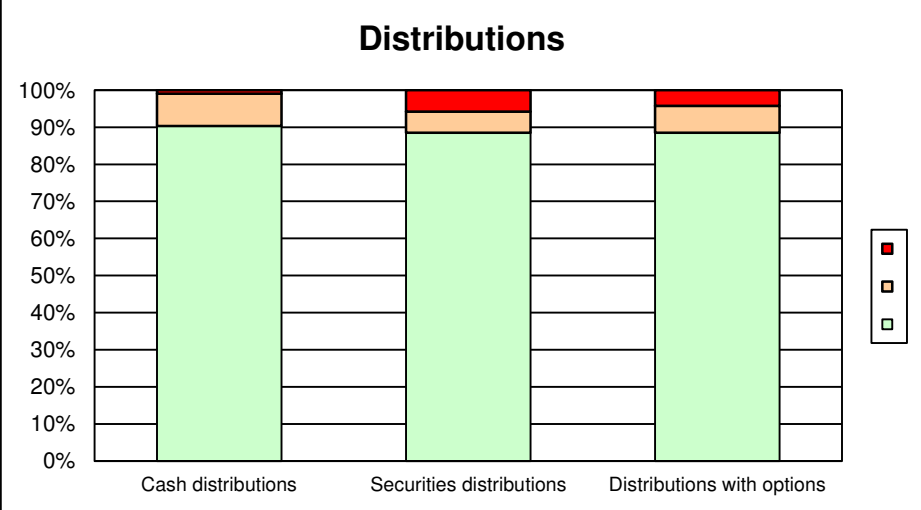
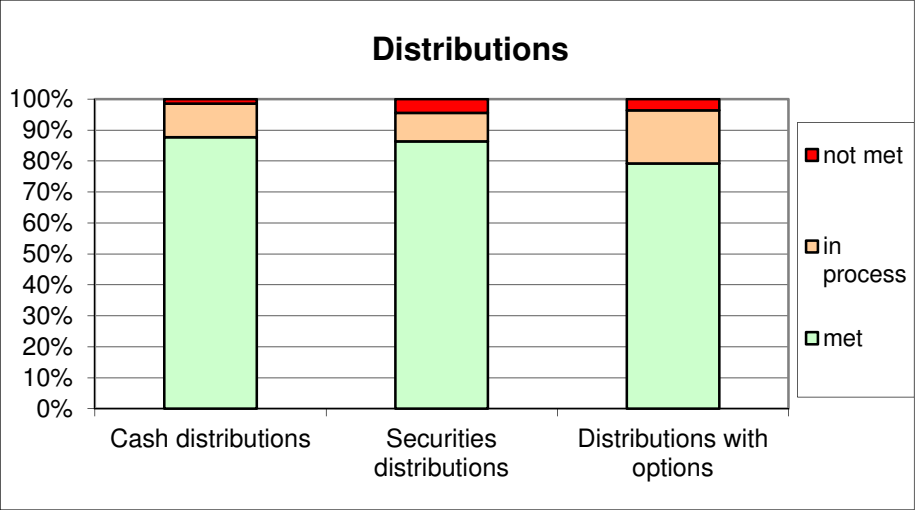
- Overall very good level of compliance with all standards at the consolidated non-weighted level of all markets; remarkably congruent picture between 8 major markets and all markets
- Yet, a significant discrepancy between an increasing number of markets that report full/near full compliance (Switzerland, Portugal, Italy, Germany, Slovenia) and markets with continuous difficulties (Czech, Norway, Sweden)
- Outstanding progress made in numerous CEE markets
- Setbacks in progress reports 2017 vs 2016 (e.g. Italy) will require explanation during this workshop
- The last bit to the top of a mountain is often the most difficult, requiring an special final effort (e.g. UK, Spain)
- Where required, relentless efforts are imperative to provide final proof of successful private sector initiative in one of the most complex post trade area – crucial to build credibility in the context of EPTF, CMU, SRD II
